

Sermon Notes: "The Solid Rock" Matthew 7:24-29

# **Big Idea:**

Jesus is telling us that in life, what matters isn't the <u>ritual</u> but the <u>substance</u> behind it.

## **Building on Bedrock:**

- The foolish builder isn't lacking <u>intelligence</u> but lacking <u>obedience</u>.
- Knowledge becomes <u>wisdom</u> only when it <u>shapes</u> our actions.
- Rock reveals itself in the <u>rain</u>.
- The world offers many voices of <u>influence</u>; Jesus offers the voice of <u>authority</u>.

## So What?

## FOUNDATION INSPECTION:

- 1. WHICH WAY AM I MOVING?
- 2. WHAT WILL <u>SURVIVE</u> THE STORM?
- 3. WHOSE <u>VOICE</u> TRULY GUIDES ME?

The wise builder didn't just <u>admire</u> the concept of a rock foundation—he did the hard work of digging deep <u>until</u> he found it. "<u>Will I</u>?"

## For Study, Reflection, Discussion:

1. Review the sermon notes from Sunday. Was there a particular point that stuck with you? *What* was it and *why* did it resonate with you?

# Read Matthew 7:24-29

- 2. Jesus uses the image of storms (rain, floods, winds) beating against both houses. What do you think these storms represent in our lives?
- 3. The crowds were amazed at Jesus' authority (exousia). What does it mean that Jesus has both the right and power to command? How is this different from other authorities in your life?
- 4. How does this parable serve as a fitting conclusion to Jesus' entire Sermon on the Mount (Matthew 5-7)?
- 5. The sermon mentioned that building on sand often looks easier in the short term. Where are you tempted to take shortcuts in your spiritual life because the proper foundation seems too difficult or time-consuming?
- 6. Darin shared the story of making a decision about foster care based initially on a coin flip, then realizing God's Word provided clearer direction. Share a time when you had to dig deeper into God's Word to make a difficult decision.

# Specific Action Step:

**This week:** Set aside 30 minutes this week for a personal "foundation inspection." Use the three questions from the sermon to evaluate your life. Write down your answers and share them with a trusted friend or accountability partner.
